This legislation would add, through the posting of an additional sign, the name Hellenic Boulevard along Bruckner Boulevard between Arnow Place and Willow Lane.

### COMMENT:

The Greek American Community of the Borough of the Bronx, along with residents of the Pelham Bay and Throgs Neck are eagerly awaiting the completion of a new Greek Orthodox Church. Located at Bruckner Boulevard between Arnow Place and Willow Place, the new church building of the Greek Orthodox Church of Zoodohos Peghe is now structurally complete and is awaiting internal decorations.

The Bronx community would like to acknowledge the service of the Church and school to the Greek community.

The Greek American community officially began to plant roots in the Bronx in 1912, with the opening of an orphanage for young Greek Americans on Eagle Avenue. As the Greek population began to grow, a visiting priest was sent by the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese to tend to their spiritual needs. Then in 1914, the Greek Orthodox Church of Zoodohos Peghe, meaning "Church of the Life Giving Fountain" opened its doors on Eagle Avenue. The Church later moved to Forest Avenue until April of 1967, when a permanent parish was established at 3573 Bruckner Boulevard, located in the neighborhood of Pelham. The site encompasses the Greek American Institute which is the oldest Greek American parochial school in the northeast, a community center and the new church building currently undergoing completion.

This orthodox Greek American community is more formally known as the Hellenic Orthodox Community of Zoodohos Peghe. Besides the buildings and institutions mentioned, the Hellenic Orthodox Community includes many religious, fraternal, philanthropic, civic and social organizations. The community hosts many functions including luncheons, dances, fund raisers and an annual festival.

Thus, in honor of the many contributions by the Greek Orthodox Church of Zoodohos Peghe to the Greek American community in the Bronx, this legislation adds the name "Hellenic Boulevard" to Bruckner Boulevard between Arnow Place and Willow Lane, at the

site of the church.
